
ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On June 30, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On July 23, 2025, HUD filed *HUD Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* stating that Petitioner has asserted that she is currently unemployed and provided HUD with a letter from her previous employer to that effect. As a result, although the debt owed to HUD is past due and legally enforceable, administrative wage garnishment of Petitioner's wages is not possible at this time and the Secretary reserves the right to again seek administrative wage garnishment against Petitioner at such time in the future that she becomes employed.

For good cause, the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
