DISMISSAL ORDER

On August 14, 2025, the Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning the Secretary's intent to garnish his wages to collect a debt he allegedly owes the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

HUD has now filed the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* seeking dismissal of this matter without prejudice. HUD states that it has suspended collection efforts against Petitioner until it receives more details from Petitioner's lender concerning the alleged debt. HUD notes that it reserves the right to seek collection of the debt through alternate means, such as administrative offset, and that it may resume wage garnishment activities in the future, should the facts reveal that Petitioner is justly indebted to HUD.

For good cause shown, the *Secretary's Motion to Dismiss* is **GRANTED** and this matter is **DISMISSED** without prejudice.
