ORDER OF DISMISSAL

On March 18, 2025, this Court received Petitioner's request for a hearing concerning a proposed repayment schedule incident to a wage garnishment order sought by the Secretary relating to a debt owed to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development ("HUD").

On July 23, 2025, HUD filed the *Secretary's Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* stating that the Secretary has determined that Petitioner's co-debtor, who is Petitioner's spouse and occupies the same household, has entered into a voluntary repayment agreement with the U.S. Department of Treasury regarding the debt that is the subject of this proceeding. As a result, the Secretary moves to dismiss this matter without prejudice and may again seek collection from Petitioner by administrative wage garnishment in the event of default of the repayment agreement.

For good cause, the Secretary's *Motion to Vacate Stay and Dismiss* will be **GRANTED**, and this matter is **DISMISSED**, without prejudice.
